Sound-Alike-Look-Alike Drugs (SALAD)

To help prevent confusion with SALAD, the following strategies are used:

- SALAD lists are **posted in strategic locations** in Nursing Units and clinical areas. This list is reviewed at least annually.
- Medications on the SALAD list are <u>not stored next to each other</u>, either in the Pharmacy, the Pyxis or the medication room.
- * <u>"SALAD Alert" stickers</u> are affixed where look- or sound-alike products are stored.
- **Brand and generic names** are printed on MAR's and Pyxis computer screens.
- When pre-packaging medication, <u>a red stripe can be used</u> to differentiate between look-alike medications.
- Physicians are encouraged to <u>specify the purpose of medications</u> on physician orders.
- Clinicians should <u>report errors and potentially hazardous conditions</u> with SALAD through variance reporting and recommendations to the Pharmacy.
- Clinical staff must <u>read back</u> all orders taken verbally or telephonically.
