

Creating Your HealthStream ID

NOTE: This is different from your existing Holy Cross HealthStream ID. This is specific to NRP so your record will cross over to the AAP site.

To create your HealthStream ID:

First login to HealthStream using your existing User ID

1. Click the **Profile** tab to open the options list.
2. Select the **Resuscitation Cards** option to open the My Resuscitation Cards page.
3. Click the **Manage HealthStream ID** link to open the HealthStream ID screen.
4. Click the **Create ID** button to open the Create HealthStream ID screen.
5. Type your first name in the **First Name** box.
6. Type your last name in the **Last Name** box.
7. Type your personal email address in the **Personal Email Address** box. This should be a personal email address, **not a work email address.**
8. Retype your personal email address in the **Confirm Personal Email Address** box. It must match exactly what you typed in the **Personal Email Address** box.
9. Type a password in the **Password** box. Your Password must contain at least 3 of the 4 elements: one upper-case letter, one lower-case letter, one number, and one special character (&, %, *, !, etc.).
10. Retype your password in the **Retype Password** box. It match exactly what you typed in the **Password** box.
11. Click the **Terms of Use** link to view the privacy policy.
12. Select the **Yes, I've read the Terms of Use** check box.
13. Click the **Save** button.
 - If you submit an email address that is already in use, you will be asked to sign in or create an account with a different email address.

When you create your HealthStream ID, the system will send a message to the email address that you provided. This message contains a link to confirm your email address. Go to your personal email account, open the message, and click the link to confirm your email address.

After you confirm your email address, you can link your HealthStream ID with your HLC student account. This is to enable your completion in HealthStream to cross over to the AAP site.

Linking Your HLC Account with Your HealthStream ID

HealthStream IDs can only be linked with HLC student accounts.

To link your Holy Cross HealthStream account with your NRP HealthStream ID:
First login to HealthStream using your existing Holy Cross HealthStream ID

1. Click the **Profile** tab to open the options list.
2. Select the **Resuscitation Cards** option to open the My Resuscitation Cards page.
3. Click the **Manage HealthStream ID** link to open the HealthStream ID screen.
4. Click the **I Already Have One** button to open the HealthStream ID Sign-In screen.
5. Enter the email address associated with your HealthStream ID in the **Personal Email Address** box.
6. Type your  HealthStream ID password in the **Password** box.
Do not use your Holy Cross HealthStream password.
7. Click the **Sign In** button.
